Dear Parents/Carers,

KS2 Theatre Visit

I am delighted to inform you that Key Stage Two will be visiting the Assembly Hall in Tunbridge Wells on Monday 6th February to see the Shakespeare 4 Kidz production of Romeo and Juliet. We will travel to the theatre by coach leaving school at 9.30am. All children should be wearing smart school uniform and a coat. The production begins at 10.30am and lasts for just over two hours, which means that we won't return to school until 1.00pm at the earliest. Children should bring a bottle of water, in a plastic bottle, and a small snack to be consumed during the interval.

On our return to school the kitchen will be closed and there won't be an opportunity to purchase a school lunch. All children therefore need to bring in a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to free school meals and you would like Alison in the kitchen to make them a packed lunch, please let their class teacher know by Thursday 2nd February at the latest.

The cost of this visit has been kindly subsidised by the PTA and is now £10 per child. No child will be treated differently according to whether or not the parents have made any contributions. However, it must be stressed that we will not be able to proceed with this activity if there is not sufficient financial support. Please complete the attached consent form and return it with your contribution to your child's class teacher. Cheques should be made payable to Forest Row C. of E. School in a named sealed envelope.
